A NEW SEASON

Partnership

I love the Greek word **koinonia**. Usually translated 'fellowship' or 'partnership', it expresses the mutuality of giving and receiving that lies at the heart of Christian ministry.

After thirty eight years in pastoral ministry, I am moving into an itinerant role: a new season of ministry. In such I will be available to partner in the following:

Pastors, Missionaries and Churches

- There are a small number of pastors in the UK and overseas I relate to as a friend, mentor and father figure. I look forward to being more available to them and to other pastors looking for support in their ministries.
- And beyond that group, I will be available for preaching and teaching in other settings: Sundays, church week-ends, leadership training etc.

The Jewish People

- It has been my privilege for many years to work alongside Menorah Ministries in Poland and Aliyah Highways in the Ukraine. The focus of these ministries is to reach out to the Jewish communities in the Former Soviet Union. They also resource local Christians and churches doing this work.
- In Poland in particular, this has led to involvement with a number of pastors and opportunities to work with them.
- The links with pastors and churches in Israel has been mutually enriching. It will be good to see these further developed.
- The church in the west is deeply divided in attitudes and convictions regarding the place of Israel today - from supersessionism to Christian Zionism. I would welcome opportunities to teach on aspects of the subject and rescue this vital truth from extremists.
- Even apart from issues of covenant and eschatology, there is no people group Christians have received more from and treated worse than the Jews. There is a debt to pay: I am praying over the possibility of applying for a Masters Course in Jewish Christian Relations to assist and further this concern.

Bible School

- At New Life Church Woking, we developed courses for those who would like to get to grips with the Bible in its original context. Along with teaching, notes are provided, homework is set and discussion is encouraged. It would be good to make this available on a wider front.
- The concept is very flexible and could be tailored to the particular requirements of any group or church.
- Details of courses can be supplied.
